Edward Mote was born in London, England in 1797 and died in 1874. It was somewhere in the 1830's that Mote is believed to have penned the words of the hymn "My Hope Is Built On Nothing Less". Having written more than 100 hymns, this one has stood the test of time.

*My hope is built on nothing less  
than Jesus' blood and righteousness;  
I dare not trust the sweetest frame,  
but wholly lean on Jesus' name.*

*On Christ, the solid rock, I stand;  
all other ground is sinking sand,  
all other ground is sinking sand.*
